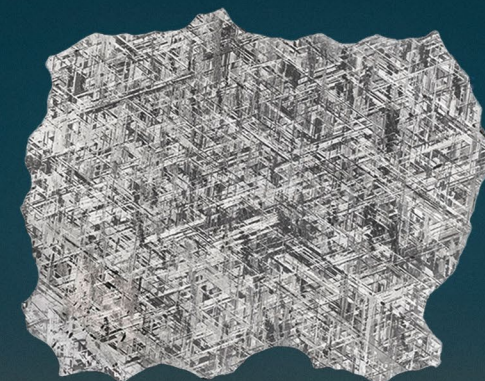

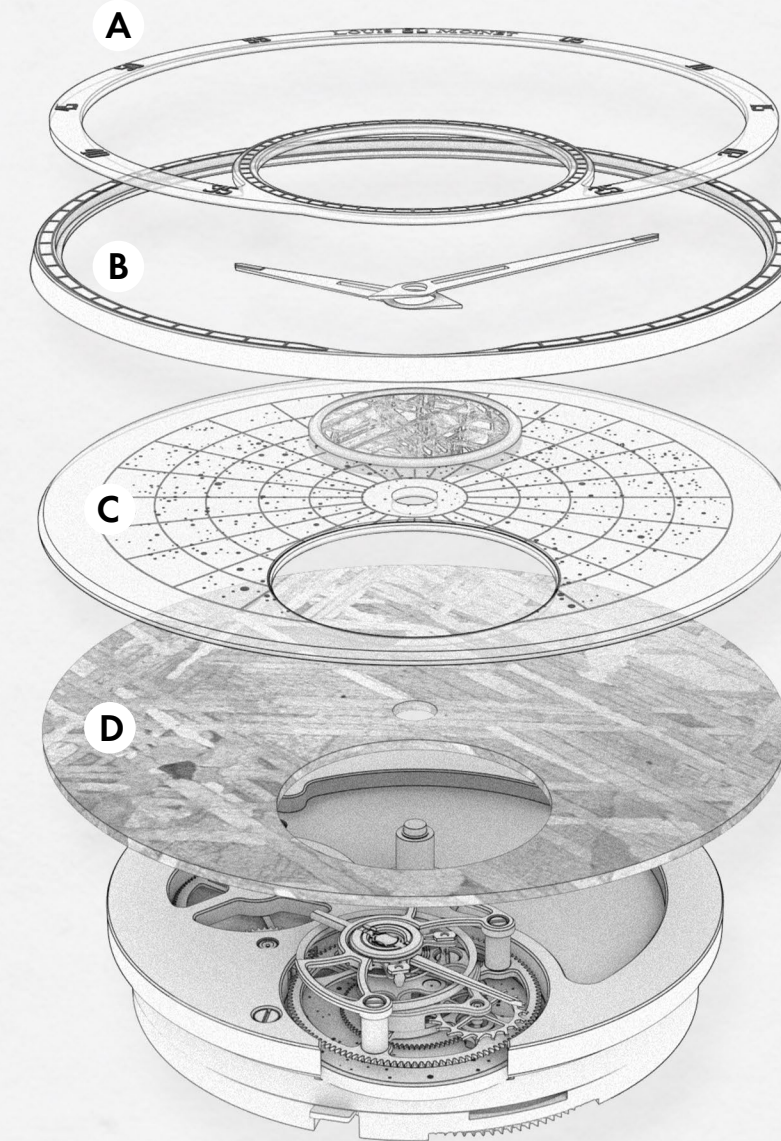


Sapphire dial with two-sided luminescent decoration

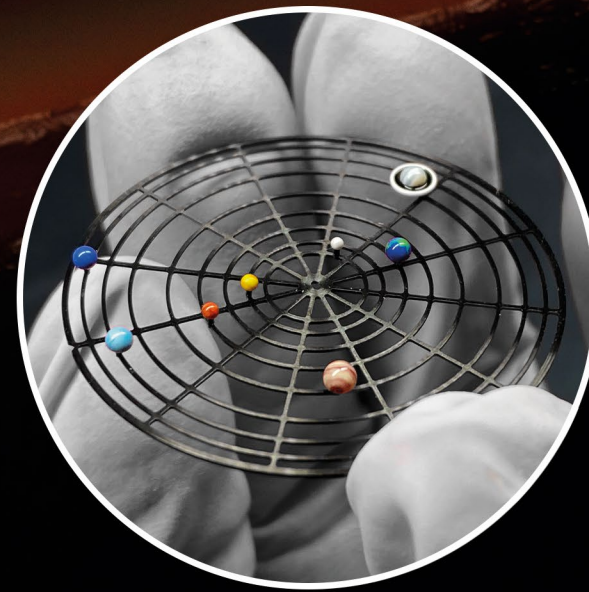
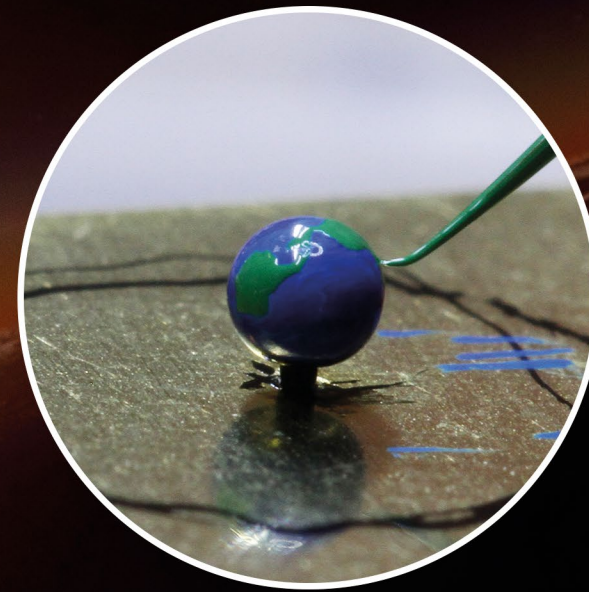
SOLAR SYSTEM
